## Vinification

The 2019 vintage proved to be an good year for white wines, with healthy and very balanced grapes.

The grapes were harvested manually, following a rigorous selection process.

This wine comes from a blend, from four grape varieties, the main ones being the Encruzado and the Barcelo.

A minimalist approach in the winery where direct pressing of the grapes was carried out, controlled fermentation and a 4-month stage on fine lees.

## Technical Analysis

Álcool 13,1%; pH 3,22; TA 6,88g/L

## Color

Yellow with green tints.

## Aroma

The wine has a lemon, citrus and white peach aroma, combined with a mineral touch, which gives it complexity and intensity.

## Palate

In the mouth the wine unfolds in layers of green fruit with details of stone fruit, combined with its typical minerality. Its high natural acidity gives good intensity, harmonized by its volume of alcohol, allowing a perfect sensory balance.

## Ageing

The wine is ready to be drink with some potential for ageing.
